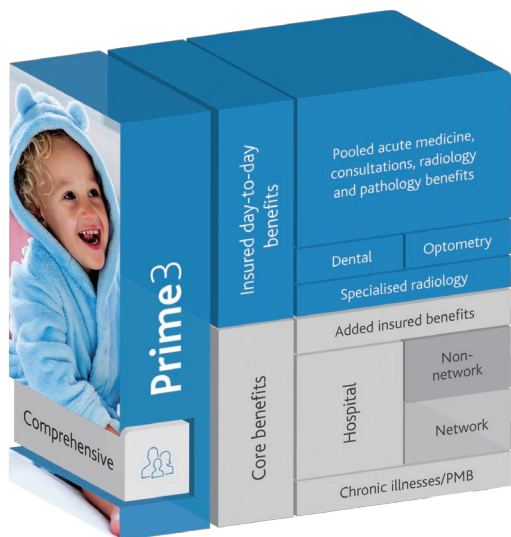


# Prime 3 product summary

This is a summary of the comprehensive Prime 3 benefit option. On Prime 3 you only pay for two children younger than 18 years after which child dependant rates will apply from the beginning of the year following the year in which they turn 18, until they are 26 years old. Older children pay child dependant rates until they are 26 years old.



## Prime3N Comprehensive

Prime 3's network option lets you save 20% in monthly contributions, with comprehensive hospital cover at a network of 113 private hospitals. It also offers generous day-to-day and added insured benefits, making it ideal for people with more extensive healthcare needs.

## Post-hospital care

Up to 30 days after discharge for speech therapy, occupational therapy and physiotherapy

## Prostheses benefits

- Health-essential functional prosthesis: R58 800
  - Hip, knee and shoulder replacements (non-PMB):
    - Acute injuries where replacement is the only treatment option
  - Hospitalisation: 100% of the MT
  - Prosthesis: Health-essential functional prosthesis benefit applies (Wear and tear: no benefits)
- Intra-ocular lenses – R3 950 per lens, 2 lenses per beneficiary per year, health-essential functional prosthesis benefit applies
- EVARS prosthesis - R124 000
- Vascular/cardiac prosthesis - R53 100
- Prosthesis with reconstructive or restorative surgery and external breast prostheses (in and out of hospital) - R9 150 per family per year

## Women's health

- A pap smear requested by a medical doctor
- A mammogram requested by a medical doctor for women 40 years and older
- A flu vaccination at Clicks/Dis-Chem pharmacy clinics



## Enhanced maternity benefits

- Free registration for and participation in the Medihelp HealthPrint pregnancy and baby programme with support and baby goodies
- Up to 12 antenatal and postnatal consultations per family at a gynaecologist, GP or midwife
- One amniocentesis screening per pregnancy
- Two 2D ultrasound scans per family
- Flu vaccination during your pregnancy at Clicks/Dis-Chem pharmacy clinics



## Child benefits

- Child flu vaccination at Clicks/Dis-Chem pharmacy clinics
- Babies under a year receive two additional visits to a GP or specialist
- Full schedule of standard child immunisations covered up to 7 years at Dis-Chem/Clicks pharmacy clinics



## Routine screening and immunisation benefits

Available at Clicks/Dis-Chem pharmacy clinics per person:

- One combo test (blood glucose, cholesterol, BMI and blood pressure measurement) or individual blood glucose or cholesterol test
- HIV testing, counselling and support
- A tetanus vaccine
- Two HPV vaccinations for boys and girls between 10-14 years, and three between 15-26 years.



## Men's health

- A prostate test (PSA level) requested by a medical doctor for men 40 years and older
- A flu vaccination at Clicks/Dis-Chem pharmacy clinics



## Additional screenings and immunisation for over 50s

- An FOBT test for people over 50 years
- Women over 50 years have access to one bone mineral density test requested by a medical doctor
- A Pneumovax vaccine in a 5-year cycle per person older than 55 years and registered on Medihelp's asthma/COPD programme
- A flu vaccination at Clicks/Dis-Chem pharmacy clinics



## Supporting wellness

### Maintain a healthy weight

- Free registration for and participation in Medihelp's HealthPrint BMI programme
- One dietician consultation per registered HealthPrint member if a BMI test result done at Clicks/Dis-Chem indicates a BMI higher than 30

### An alternative to surgery

- Back treatment at a Document-Based Care facility for patients who qualify for this benefit

### Chronic Care programme

- People who suffer from high blood pressure, high cholesterol and diabetes simultaneously have access to Medihelp's Chronic Care programme, which will provide personal support through a care coordinator to assist in maintaining and optimising their well-being

## Insured dental benefits

- Conservative services (including routine check-ups, fillings, X-rays and oral hygiene)
- Specialised services (including crowns, bridges and orthodontic treatments)

## External prostheses and medical appliances (in and out of hospital)

- Benefit per family per 3-year cycle:
  - Artificial eyes - R4 500
  - Wheelchairs - R4 500
  - Speech and hearing aids - R4 500
  - Artificial limbs - R4 500
- Medical appliances and hyperbaric oxygen treatment - R1 200 per year
- CPAP apparatus - R9 250 per beneficiary per 24-month cycle

### Procedure-specific deductibles (payable by the member)

- **Back and neck fusion** – R8 650 per admission
- **Endoscopic procedures** – gastroscopy, colonoscopy, arthroscopy and sigmoidoscopy
  - In a day clinic – R2 000, in hospital – R3 050
- **Specialised radiology** – R1 600 per examination
- **Dental procedures under general anaesthesia during hospitalisation**
  - Removal of impacted teeth and extensive dental treatment for children <5 years – R880 per admission
